

Real Education Costs only 1 Swiss Franc

In many parts of Africa, early childhood education is very weak. Kindergartens lack skilled workers and materials. As a result, children must sit and repeat for hours without learning anything sustainable.

The **Swiss School System project** (<https://school-sys.org>) is an educational system for schools with minimal resources. It consists of ❶ the simplest educational materials, combined with ❷ coaching, ❸ prepared lessons on an online platform and a ❹ controlling system. This enables exceptional teaching at minimal cost.

The **Swiss association 2givelife.org** (<https://2givelife.org>) develops this system and runs projects in Tanzania and South Africa.

Our **mission is to offer a meta-system** that systematizes education and enables rapid expansion through other partners. It is like a franchise system, for example McDonald's.

Swiss School System is **documented, automated and standardized** with processes and checklists. This means the system can be expanded to hundreds of locations with thousands of schools.

Our **vision is to change the fate of millions of children** through an exceptional, value-based basic education that promotes personal responsibility and self-help. We work with local schools, organizations and hand craft businesses.

Funding comes from donations and school sponsorships. With an average of CHF 1'200, we cover the annual costs of a school with 30-50 children.

In the current expansion **stage GrowUp27** we want to expand the support to 500 schools and 20'000 children. This requires around CHF 600'000 annually.
